# DVRA Amateur Radio License Course

**Part 1 of 2: Friday, August 3, 2012, 1-4 PM**

The Delaware Valley Radio Association (DVRA) will hold a no-fee, two-part Amateur Radio License Course in August, 2012. Part 1 will be Friday, August 3, 1-4 PM. Part 2 will be Friday, August 10, 1-4 PM. The location will depend on the number of students who sign up. The course will teach you how to pass the simple 35-question multiple-choice test needed to get your Federal Communications Commission Amateur Radio License. The exam will be given at the end of the second session. Knowledge of Morse code is not required for this license and there is no minimum age requirement.

While there is no fee for the course, the textbook costs \$18, payable at the first class. There is also a fee of \$15 to take the FCC license exam, payable at the test session ending the course.

If you are a Boy Scout in the Mercer Area District, please note that earning your Amateur Radio License is Requirement (1) to qualify for the Handheld Transceiver Special Purchase Offer, see [http://mad-bsa.org/fall2012/special\\_offer\\_09jul2012.pdf](http://mad-bsa.org/fall2012/special_offer_09jul2012.pdf).

The other two requirements to qualify for the Handheld Transceiver Special Purchase Offer are:

(2) Your patrol must commit to do a Level 4 Mystery Course at The Radio Patrol Mystery Camporee.

(3) Your patrol must have constructed a directional antenna.
