- 1. Shooting competition for the council from Jan through May.
- 2. 2 divisions for each district:(a) Boy Scouts (b) Venturers, Explorers, and Sea Scouts.
- 3. Each division will be divided into 2 groups based on age.
- 4. There will be an individual winner for each district/division/age group.
- 5. There will be a team competition. A team will be made up of 4 individuals, with the total of the best 3 individual's scores. There will be a team winner for each district/division/age group.
- 6. The competition will be held at Foster Hall. The first date will be Sunday, Jan. 11th, registration starts at noon and shooting will begin at 1. We will finish by 4. You do not have to stay the entire time. Your team mates to not have to shoot the same time you do. The other dates are Feb. 22nd, March 15th, April 12th, and May17th.
- 7. We will be using Crossman air rifles. Each participant will fire 20 shots, 5 at each target. The first target, five shots, is for practice. The next three targets count.
- 8. The cost is \$5/person/month.
- 9. The shooting sports committee needs members from each district. Next year we envision each district running their own competition. Training opportunities will be available.
